

**SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS**

Formation of the Board

The Missouri State Board of Education has established sub-districts for the District as follows:

The Board of Education shall, each decade within ninety (90) days following the publication of the final decennial census figures, adopt a resolution calling for the formation of a redistricting committee. Upon adoption of such resolution, the secretary of the Board of Education shall forward a certified copy to the state board of education with a request that a redistricting committee be appointed in order to establish new sub-districts based on population.

The redistricting committee shall consist of

- a. three residents within the district, appointed by the Board of Education of the Special School District, and
- b. three (3) additional persons resident within the Special School District, appointed by the State Board of Education.

The Redistricting Committee shall meet, organize itself with a chairperson and secretary, and proceed with the adoption of a redistricting plan. Any plan proposed to be adopted must receive approval of a majority of the whole redistricting committee. Upon adoption, the Redistricting Committee shall forward a copy of the plan certified by the secretary of the Redistricting Committee to the State Board of Education for its approval or disapproval. The State Board of Education shall approve any redistricting plan taking into account insofar as possible existing school district boundary lines. All board members selected thereafter shall be selected from sub-districts in which they are resident.

If the plan is not approved, then it shall be returned to the Redistricting Committee for revision and resubmission. If a redistricting plan has not been adopted within one (1) year after the publication of the decennial census figures, the State Board of Education shall provide the redistricting plan.

No member of the Redistricting Committee shall serve on the Board of Education for a period of six (6) years following such service on the redistricting committee.

#### School Board Elections

Members of the Board are elected from the seven (7) sub-districts, as provided by state law. Each of the seven (7) sub-districts must be represented by a person who resides in the sub-district represented. Partner Districts within the area served by Special School District may not be divided in establishing sub-districts.


The Governing Council will issue a procedure describing the process for public notice, application, interview, and election of Board members, as per state statute.

By September 1 of each year, Board of Education members whose seats are up for election the following year are encouraged to declare whether they intend to run for re-election.

When a candidate files for election, the candidate must sign the following documents which will be kept in the district's files:

1. A declaration of candidacy form (BBB AF-2).
2. An acknowledgement of having received information about the requirements of the Missouri Ethics Commission and his/her obligation to file a financial interest statement (BBB AF3 and AF-4).
3. Signed Department of Revenue Form (5120) stating that the candidate is not aware of delinquency in Income Tax, Personal Property Tax, Municipal Tax or Real Property Tax.
