



## **Special School District of St. Louis County Special Non-public Access Program (SNAP) Service Guidance**

### **Overview**

The purpose of this plan is to outline guidance for offering Special Non-public Access Program (SNAP) services for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. These guidelines have been carefully considered to address and promote the safety, health, and welfare of our students, families, and staff.

This plan was put in effect through the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year. The plan has been reviewed to determine if changes are warranted prior to second semester based on CDC and St. Louis County Health Department recommendations. It has been determined that the plan will remain in effect through second semester of the 2020-2021 school year.

### **Plan**

- SNAP services for the 2020-2021 school year will be available in a modified format. This may include a combination of the following:
  - Virtual drop-in sessions with SNAP instructors and therapists provided in small groups during each student's regularly scheduled SNAP time
  - Weekly telephone/e-mail contact with families
  - Strategies, activities, and resources to support families at home will be sent electronically. For families without access to technology, learning packets may be provided upon request.

- A Distance Learning Plan will be developed for each student based on the services included in their Services Plan.
- Annual Service Plan meetings will be held virtually throughout the 2020-2021 school year. These virtual conferences will include SNAP service providers, families, and non-public representatives.
