

## ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Where do I go on the first day of school?

- Students will report to the North Tech Gymnasium for New Student Orientation. Here, students will hear from Principals, Counselors, Social Workers, Instructors, and the Admissions Team. Student schedules will be available online through [SISK12](#), typically one (1) week prior to the first day of school.

### What do I need for the first day of school?

### Does North Tech serve meals?

- Breakfast is available every morning in the Cafeteria starting at 7:10am.
  - Breakfast will be \$2.10 and a reduced cost of \$.30.

- Lunch will NOT be provided.

### What happens when Tech has school but my homeschool doesn't?
